

Rigs: the force that powers your ride

The rig is the windsurfer's engine. Consisting of a sail, a mast that supports it vertically, a boom which is both horizontal support and handle, base extension to adjust the mast length, and the base which connects the rig to the board and permits it to pivot on a universal joint. There are many brands and models of each part, with different features and quality. For beginners the most important issues are the size of the sail, which must be big enough to get you going, but not overpowering, and the mast, which should be two-piece for easy transportation, and have at least some carbon to reduce weight and ensure proper bend. Lighter feels better, but costs more.



Chinook Power Glide Rig

In the past many value priced rigs suffered from lower quality hardware. No worries here! Chinook has a well earned reputation for functionality and strength, so you know this kit is solid. The Package includes an X-Ply reinforced Ezzy built sail, 2 piece epoxy mast, Aluminum mast extension, 1 bolt tendon base, uphaul, and Competition boom.

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

Which board is right for you? First, pick your sailing style.

Freeride boards are what most intermediate to advanced sailors enjoy for all-around use. Fast enough, easy to turn, and comfortable to ride even in choppy water. If you are working on gybes or footstraps, the boards on this page will help you get there. If you are already proficient, but don't want a specialized, single-use board, you'll have fun on any of them.

Freestyle wave boards are for medium & higher wind use in a variety of conditions. Some are geared more for freestyle tricks, some for onshore wave riding, and others for bump & jump in chop or Gorge conditions, but all have some balance of speed, turning, and rough water control.

Freestyle boards are a must for new-school tricks, but also very maneuverable and fun to ride. They plane and accelerate quickly for their volume, but they are not lightwind boards by mainland standards. Top speed and upwind performance are somewhat limited.

RRD X-Ride

This easy turning freeride is quick to plane and motors upwind. It's accessible, but has a fast feel. The fin and foot straps are first-rate, and the build is solid.



Wave Sails

Wave sails come in several sub-categories, depending on the intended use. Many are fine all-around high wind sails for small waves or bump & jump use. Some are dedicated surf sails, ideal for down-the-line, big wave riding, but limited for anything else. On-shore or "euro wave" sails have better speed and upwind ability. "Power wave" have more acceleration, good for fluky winds, or busting through shore-break. Consider your prevalent conditions. Buying a Maui style sail to use in a duck pond is inefficient, but using a flimsy freeride sail in big surf is a recipe for disaster.

Fins - fine tune your ride!

Next to the sail, the fin is perhaps the most dynamic and important componant in a windsurfing kit, yet seldom given much consideration by many windsurfers. Even the best board can't perform to full potential without a quality fin. To get the full range from your favorite stick, try changing fins for different conditions. If there are weeds or grass in the water, a weed fin is must-have. For upwind speed, a stiffer straighter blade is advantageous. For control is rough water, or improved handling on a wave, try a slightly softer, more swept back fin. Special events like racing or freestyle call for special fin designs. In general bigger riders, bigger boards, and bigger sails require bigger fins. Feel free to call or e-mail us for specific recommendations.

The **Drive** is a shallow water fin that is quick to plane and points very well. The larger models are optimized for the latest generation of "wide style" boards. Smaller sizes the emphasis is on power and control; also good for freestyle because of their quick acceleration. **Drive** - **Pointer** - *Core* G-10

Masts are the backbone of a windsurfing rig. Getting the right length and stiffness is critical to achieving the best performance from your sail. Masts with a higher percentage of carbon are lighter, which improves handling and reduces fatigue. High carbon masts also respond quicker to changing wind.

If you are going out in surf conditions, you'll need a waverated mast. Reduced diameter "skinny" masts are especially durable, but only work well with certain sails. Usually larger sails require standard diameter.

Cambered sails, especially race sails, may need a specific bend curve and taper. It is best to follow the sail makers' advice on compatibility. Feel free to call or e-mail us with questions or for specific recommendations.



Harnesses and harness Lines: necessary equipment for powered sailing.

We are often asked "when should I use a harness?" and "what is best, a seat or waist harness?" **Seat or Waist?.** is mostly a matter of preference, but generally better sailors on small manuever oriented boards prefer a waist harness and racing sailors and big board sailors with big sails prefer a seat harness. **When should I use a Harness?** A harness is an important part of getting your board planing and going fast enough to get into the footstraps. When you have mastered basic sail handling you are ready to start using a harness to put your weight into the rig and start using big enough sails to plane with. You'll go faster, sail longer, and have more fun when you ride with with a harness.

A little wetsuit common sense to keep you warm and extend your season!

We do most of our sailing in Wisconsin where the best winds are usually in the cooler temperatures of the spring and fall. Wherever you sail there are probably times when you need the protection of the right amount of neoprene to stay comfortable and warm while out on the water.

What is the right amount of Neoprene? It depends on the temperature of the air and water you are going to sail in.

"We use the 100 degree rule. Generally if the Air and the Water temperature add up to 100+ degrees a 5/3 Steamer should be warm enough."

This may vary plus or minus 5 degrees depending on your metabolism. If you want to sail in cooler temperatures than 100 degrees you need a drysuit or you will want to add thermal layering with a thermo shirt or shorts. We like the design of Steamers because you can get in and out of these suits by yourself. A friend is required to help zip and unzip the horizontal zippers on drysuits.

Just like snow skiing, If your feet get cold put on a hat. When the air or water temperature go below 65 degrees, your body can no longer generate enough heat to keep your core warm without insulation. Your body is wired to keep your brain warm even at the expense of your feet or hands going numb. So put on a hood or hat and your body won't waste valuable energy keeping your brain warm and there will be extra heat to circulate warm blood to your hands and feet.

Windsurf suits are designed for above the water as opposed to scuba suits that are designed for underwater. Windsurfing suits minimize forearm fatigue with oversized forearm areas. The typical suits are designed with multiple thickness neoprene to give warmth and flexibility where needed. Smooth skin sheds water quickly to minimize the cooling effect of water evaporating off the suit. Most of the suit is black to absorb the suns heat.

In Wisconsin it is cold 5/3 Steamer weather until it is almost too warm for even a Shorty wetsuit, so we think of 4/3 Steamers and 3/3 Long legged convertible suits as luxury items. Where you sail it might be just right for these suits. It is always a good idea to check with the old salts to see what they use at your favorite sailing venue.



Start Kiteboarding

Kiteboarding, also called kite surfing, is an exciting sport. It is not hard to learn, but requires good instruction and practice.

The best way to get started is to buy a trainer kite and instructional DVD. Watch the video to help visualize kite control, then practice using the trainer until you can "fly blind" by steering the kite wherever you want it without the need to look at the kite or control bar.

Once you master the small kite, you are ready for a lesson on a full sized kite. Be sure your instructor is a professional with IKO and / or PASA certification.

You will fly the big kite on land first, learning to control its considerable power, then move to the water for body drags and water launch practice.

When you are comfortable with power management, launching and landing, and can drag in both directions at-will, you can strap on a board and have some serious fun!

Most riders need about 5 to 10 hours of land practice with a trainer, and 5 to 10 hours of instruction to get the basics, but it is different for everyone. The better you are at flying the trainer, the quicker you'll make friends with the big kites, so practice practice practice.


